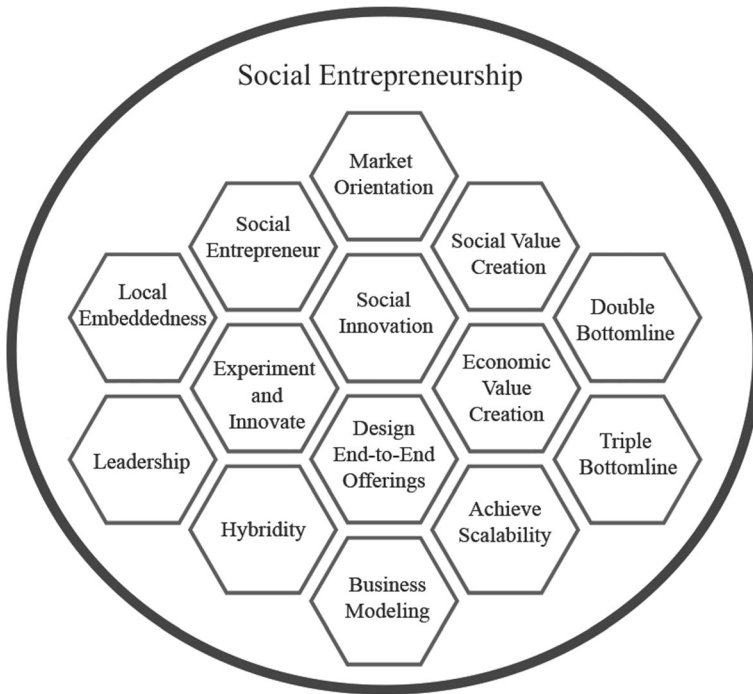


Fig. 1 The Umbrella of Social Entrepreneurship

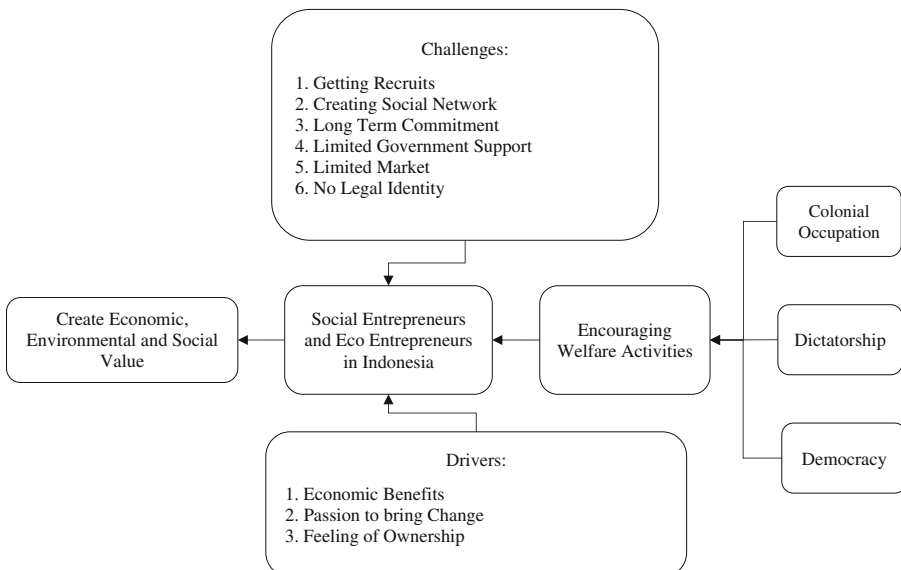


Fig. 6 Social Entrepreneurship in Indonesia
