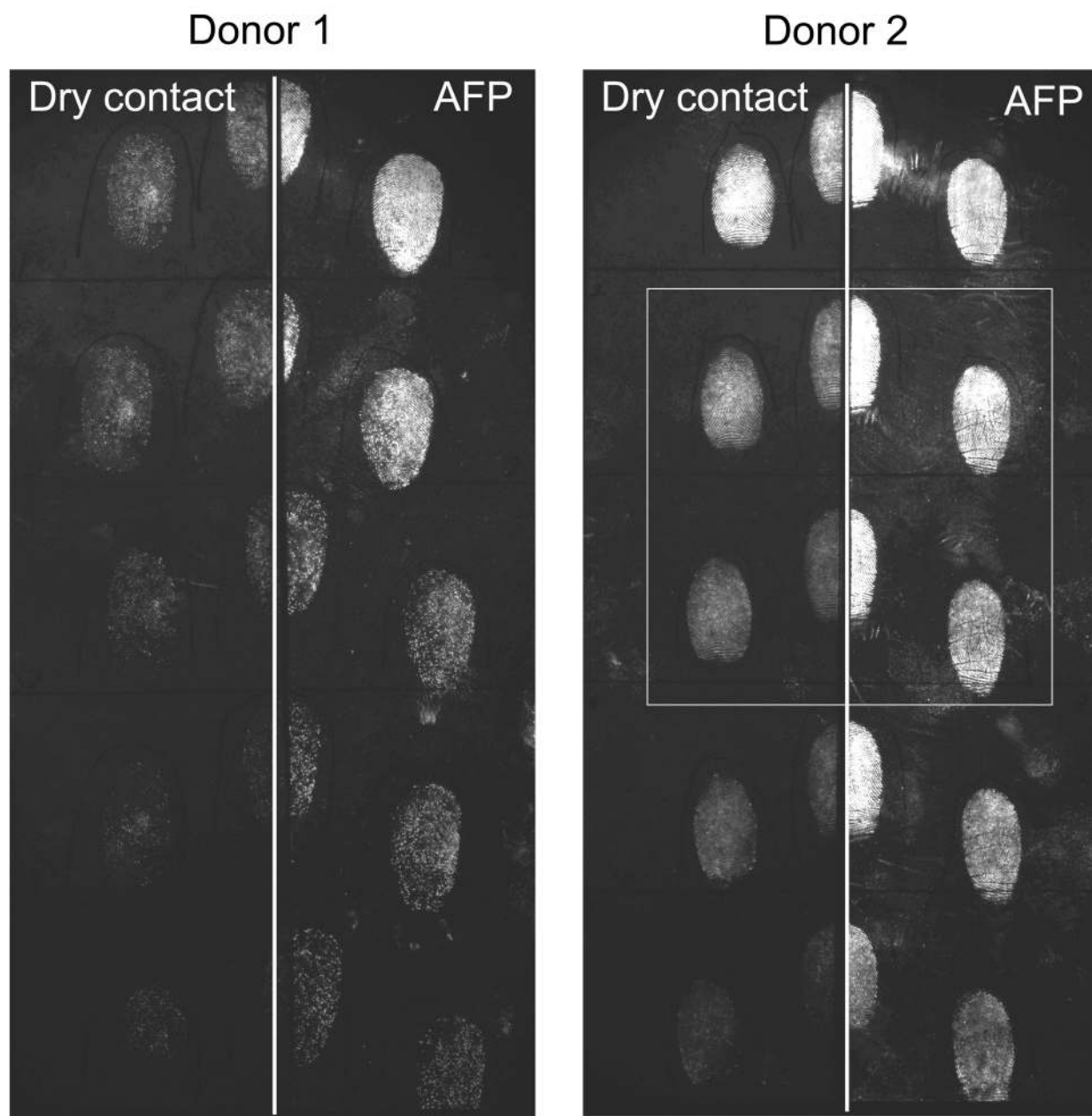


## Detection of latent fingermarks on thermal printer paper by dry contact with 1,2-indanedione

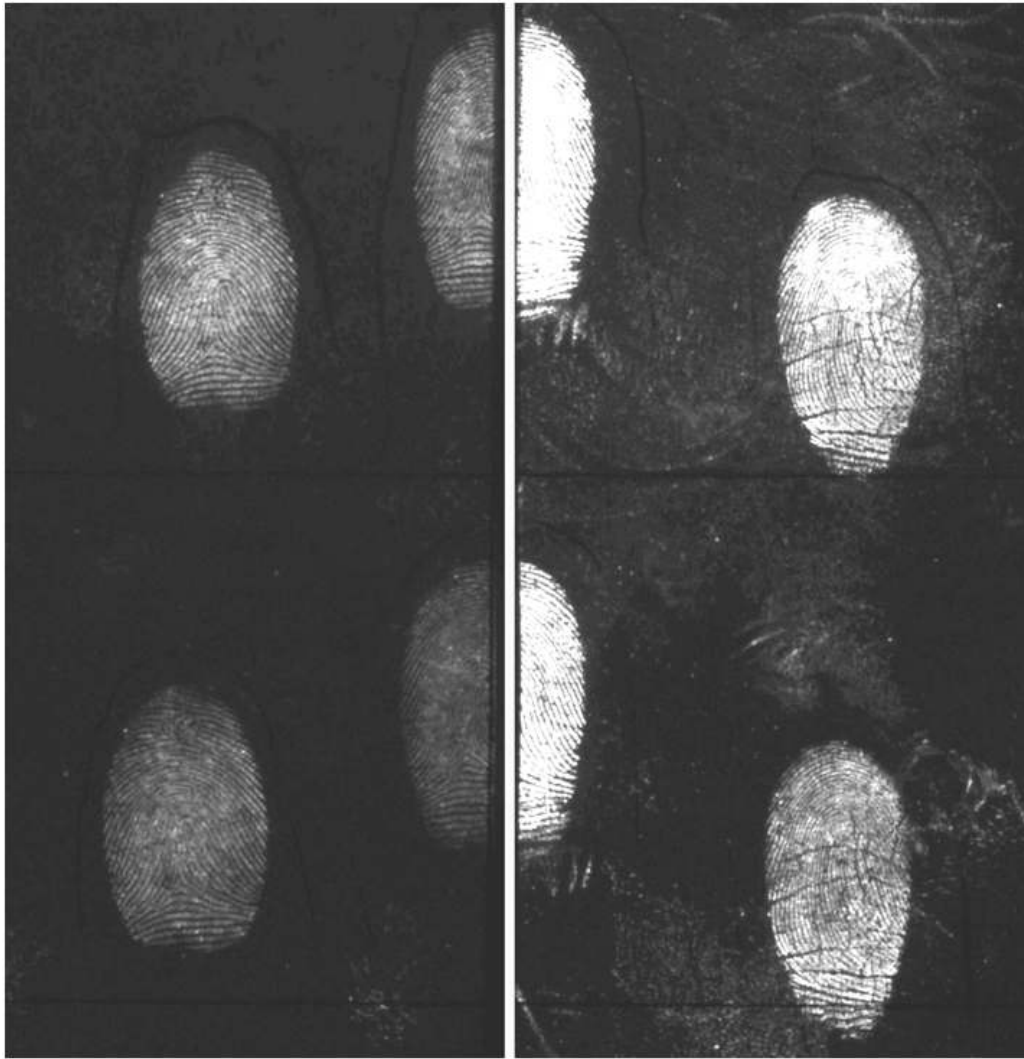
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**Fig.S1** A depletion series from two donors on white photocopy paper, where halves were treated with fluoros IND/ZnCl<sub>2</sub> using the dry contact method with additional heating or the AFP method for non-thermal papers (dipping and heat treatment). Photographs taken using a Nikon D300 Camera taken in luminescence mode with settings; Focal length: 60 mm, Shutter Speed: 1/2.5 s and Aperture: f/14. The region highlighted with the box has been expanded in Figure S2.
