We have noted a minor, but misleading, error in Part I. In column one of Table 7, the entry for transportation WDL under citation b should read 0.34–0.62. The decimal was inadvertently left out of the second value. The range of sums at the bottom of the column is correct.

A second point concerns a comment in Part II in which we credit Herbert Inhaber with the first attempt made to analyze risk of a technology considering its entire life span. Since publication of our manuscript, we have realized that this type of comparison was performed earlier at the Jet Propulsion Laboratory (Caputo, R. 1977 An initial comparative assessment of orbital and terrestrial central power systems. JPL-900-780. California Institute of

Technology, Pasadena CA) and at the University of California, Berkeley (Smith, Weyant, and Holdren. Group Report ERG 75-5. Evaluation of conventional power systems. Energy and Resources 1975). The data base from these reports was drawn upon at length by Inhaber for his assessment (Inhaber, H., Risk of energy production. AECB-1119/Rev. 3, 1979). The authors regret this oversight.
