Michel: Efficacy of Continuous versus Intermittent Administration of Penicillin G in Streptococcus pneumoniae Pneumonia in Normal and Immunodeficient Rats (Vol. 3, No. 2, p. 131–135). Page 135, line 10 should read: "In case of the intermittent treatment schedule, recovery from infection in CVF-treated rats was achieved only by a 25-fold

increase in the daily penicillin dose administered intramuscularly at 12 h or 8 h intervals (daily doses 100 or 102 mg/kg). Merrikin and Rolinson found that sub-MIC levels of different penicillins may well be adequate to result in a therapeutic effect in experimental intraperitoneal and intramuscular infections caused by Staphylococcus aureus or Escherichia coli in mice ..."
