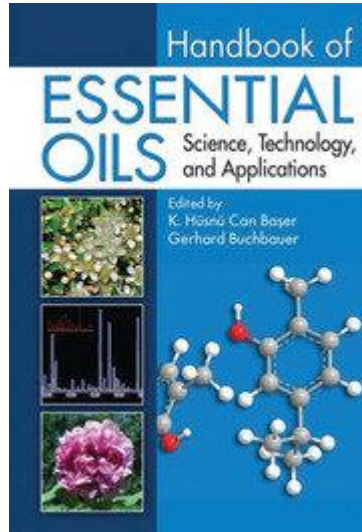


## BOOK REVIEW
