Comments:

- 1. A comparison of serological markers in this study with those of previous studies in blood donors in Cameroon could be interesting. This comparison must take into account the assays used in these previous studies.
- 2. HCV immunoblot: this kind of assay is never (or very rarely) used in Europe for diagnosis or blood screening. Is there an added value in the present study in Cameroon?
