

SELECTED BIBLIOGRAPHY OF TOKYO WITH EMPHASIS ON HER GEOGRAPHY

There are few recent bibliographies on the geography of Tokyo written in Western languages. So, this bibliography has been compiled for foreign geographers who will attend the coming International Geographical Congress in Tokyo, being held in summer 1980. Its coverage includes books, maps and periodical articles, almost all of which were published after 1960.

The bibliography is organized into twelve parts according to subjects: general, statistics, maps and atlases, landforms and geology, climate, water, vegetation, disasters and pollution, urban studies, population, industries, transportation, and history. Within each part, books and articles are arranged by their published year, and for the same year by author in the alphabetical sequence. The title of books and the name of periodicals are shown in *italic* form.

Unfortunately, only limited number of books and articles are written in Western languages, and majority are written in Japanese, the title of which are translated into English, in addition with original Japanese title written by Romanized letter in parentheses. Periodicals are academic or popular ones, the former of which are shown according to their official English titles, and the latter in Japanese with their English translation in parentheses. The last marks in parentheses indicate used languages: J . . . Japanese, E . . . English, F . . . French, G . . . German; small letters of which show the presence of abstract written in another language.

The compilers know that this is far from being satisfactory, and is full of lacks to be added. It is their wish to get advices and additions from Japanese and foreign geographers, so that they will be able to revise and republish it in some years. They hope, nevertheless, this will be of some use for foreign researchers interested in Tokyo.
