



The biotechnological manipulation of antibiotic production is one of the most promising industrial application domains of Synthetic Biology. This conference brings together the most prominent players in this emerging field, from academia and industry, to discuss recent advances and future directions for the application of synthetic biology in filamentous fungi and actinomycete bacteria.

Participants from all areas of Synthetic Biology, including combinatorial biochemistry, metagenomics, mathematical and computational modeling, cell engineering, molecular cell biology and biotechnology, are invited to apply and will then be selected for participation.

Support grants will be available for early stage researchers to cover the conference fee and, possibly, part of the travel costs. Grants are distributed based on financial need and scientific merit. Grantees must attend the entire conference in order to benefit from the grant.
